

Bible Journaling

I pray that each one of you will grow closer to the Lord through this Bible reading challenge. May the Lord be our hope, joy, greatest desire, and the One for whom we live!

I highly recommend you all to keep a Bible Journal. After reading the portion each day, choose a verse or two to meditate on and apply to your life. **Write out the verse** in your journal, and then **write praise** to God for who He is and what He has done, and **prayer** for applying these verses to your life. You can also write a prayer following A.C.T.S. (Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, Supplication).

Below is an example. Everyone's Bible Journal is unique. Yours may be very similar to mine, or very different.

"But let all those rejoice who put their trust in You; Let them ever shout for joy because You defend them; Let those also who love Your name be joyful in You. For You, O LORD, will bless the righteous; With favor You will surround him as with a shield."
